The club has received a query concerning a vehicle registered under the Special Interest Vehicle Scheme being entered in the Endeavour Rally.

This query was referred to our State Body, Queensland Historic Motoring Council and the President asked DTMR about this.

The answer that was returned to us is below:

### From QHMC:

The Great Endeavour Rally is organised by Endeavour Foundation - and not an incorporated vehicle club. The official response from TMR on this question is below and, as **this event does not fit into any of the categories, it is not an event a concessionally registered vehicle can participate in.**

### Answer from DTMR:

"Great Endeavour Rally

Under the Special Interest Vehicle (SIV) Scheme Guide, registered operators must confine their vehicles use to (among some others):

- participating in rallies organised by incorporated vehicle clubs
- participating in processions for which a Special Events Permit has been issued under the Transport Operations (Road Use Management Accreditation and Other Provisions) Regulation 2015
- exhibiting the vehicle in displays, fetes or similar functions conducted for religious, charitable or educational purposes

If the Great Endeavour Rally falls under one of the above, then a SIV may be used at the event."

As the President of QHMC, Christine Stevens has pointed out in her reply, the event **does not fall under any of the above guidelines.**

Hope this clears up this question for our members. (Please note that CTP insurance may be voided for those SIVS vehicles used outside the guidelines.)
